RECOMMENDATION

CALIFORNIA INTEGRATED WASTE MANAGEMENT ACT

DISCUSSION AND POSSIBLE ACTION: Staff to provide an update on the status of activities related to the Act.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The five-year review of the Integrated Waste Management Plan and its associated elements is underway. Staff is reviewing the possibility that they may be able to submit a Local Task Force (LTF) letter of determination that the documents do not need to be revised by the end of September. The LTF letter and report would go to the Supervisors and California Integrated Waste Management Board (CIWMB) at the same time.

At its September Board Meeting, the CIWMB approved without comment the following agenda item:

"Consideration Of The 2003/2004 Biennial Review Findings For The Source Reduction And Recycling Element And Household Hazardous Waste Element For Napa (Unincorporated), Upper Valley Waste Management Agency."

Essentially, this action is an endorsement of our integrated waste management programs for the subject time frame.
