RECOMMENDATION

CALIFORNIA INTEGRATED WASTE MANAGEMENT ACT

DISCUSSION AND POSSIBLE ACTION: Staff to provide an update on the status of activities relevant to the Act.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Grants and State Payment Funds - The state (CalRecycle) has distributed 2009-10 beverage container and litter reduction funds (formerly, "DOC" funds). All recipient up-valley cities have forwarded their share of funds to Upper Valley Waste Management Agency (UVA). About \$20,000 of the \$25,000 pool of funds is available for UVA beverage container recycling and litter abatement projects. According to CalRecycle staff, the next payment (2010-2011 funds) will be distributed to local agencies in June, 2010.

<u>Composting Workshops</u> - The last up-valley home composting workshop was held Sat., Aug. 28 at the White Barn in St. Helena. Over twenty residents attended. Up-valley residents can still sign-up on the City of Napa website for the remaining two workshops, to be held this October in Napa and American Canyon.

- Motor Oil and Oil Filter Recycling**- used oil and filter collections sites are at PUC in Angwin, Fulton Av. in St. Helena, Yountville Corp. Yard, and Clover Flat Landfill (see phone book recycling guide for details)
