Chapter 19.15 RECREATION AND OPEN SPACE

19.15.010 Purpose.

The purpose for establishing these recreation and open space districts and permitted uses is to:

A. Maintain adequate open spaces to protect environmental resources, provide recreational opportunities, and contribute "relief" from urban and suburban activities;

B. Preserve the important environmental resources of the city;

C. Accommodate passive recreation, hiking and equestrian activities;

D. Preclude development or activities in wetlands and significant habitats. (Ord. 2001-02 § 1 (part), 2001)

19.15.020 Permitted uses.

Table 19.15.020 of this chapter sets forth the permitted and conditionallypermitted uses for each public district. A "P" designates a permitted use. A "C" indicates a conditionally-permitted use subject to approval of a use permit by the planning commission. If no letter is found opposite a particular use, it is not permitted in that district.
