What is accepted for Pick-Up

- 1. General Waste. Waste must be placed in bags or boxes weighing less than 35lbs or 2 cubic yards. Small amounts of wood, furniture, cushions, chairs, shelves, end-of-life bicycles, toys, mattresses, yard debris in bags, sporting equipment, carpeting, BBQs, are acceptable for collection. <u>2 cubic yard limit per household.</u>
- Electronic Waste. Please separate all E-waste from other waste items. <u>These items will be collected separately</u> and will not go to the landfill. E-waste includes: computers, key boards, VCRs, TVs, phones, cell phones, fax machines, microwaves, irons, blenders, vacuum cleaners, and anything with a cord.
- Large Appliances. An extra fee will apply if you have the following items: Air Conditioner, Dishwasher, Washer, Dryer, Refrigerator, Water Heater, Stove, and Vehicle Tires. <u>Please call our office in advance to notify us about</u> the item and authorize the charge to your account, 707-963-7988.

We Cannot Accept: Household Hazardous Waste, NO liquid of any kind, propane tanks, dirt, rock, concrete, bricks and tree stumps. Car parts, batteries of any kind, CFL lights bulbs and tubes. This is not a recycling event, NO mixed recycling, bottles, cans, plastic containers. Please use your blue cart on regular collection day for recycling and regular green waste materials.

All Items must be placed at the curbside by 7am on Saturday May 13th, 2017. There is a 2 cubic yard limit per household. We cannot physically pick up items weighing more than 35lbs.
