| <mark>SB 19</mark> Stream Gages | Dodd | 3/12/19-Pass Senate Natural Resources/Water; referred to Appropriations. 4/2/19- Set for hearing in Appropriations on 4/8/19 | Required the Department of Water Resources, upon appropriation by the Legislature, to develop a plan to deploy a network of stream gages to monitor stream health that includes a determination of funding needs and opportunities for reenacting existing gages. | LS: 2/25/19 BOS: 4/16/2019 Status: PENDING |

| SB 670 Emergency Communications | McGuire | 4/2/19-Passed Senate Energy, Utilities and Commerce; referred to Senate Governmental Organization 4/9/19-Passed Senate Governmental Organization; referred to Appropriations | Requires a provider of telecommunications services that provides access to 911 service, to provide responder outage notification by electronic mail to the Office of Emergency Services whenever an outage occurs limiting the provider's customers' ability to make 911 calls or receive emergency notification. | PLATFORM LS: 3/25/2019 Position: SUPPORT |
