

Napa Creek to Bay Cleanup Recycling Info Sheet



- ♻️ Volunteers receive 2 bags – one for trash, and one for recycling
- ♻️ Please remember to properly separate trash and recyclables
- ♻️ Recycling is **only**: aluminum & tin cans, scrap metal, plastic & glass bottles, and **CLEAN** paper & cardboard.




- ♻️ **Do not** recycle wet, dirty, or soiled paper products of any kind or plastic bags, tubs, trays, styrofoam or other plastic packaging.

- ♻️ Stack full bags next to trash and recycling bins – they will be counted at the end of the event. Full trash bags weigh approximately 15 lbs; full recycling bags weigh 12 lbs.

- ♻️ After they are counted, put all bags into the proper bins. Each Napa site will have bins for trash and recycling - NRWS will haul away the full bins after the event.

- ♻️ What if you find tires, computers, TVs, cell phones, batteries, fluorescent bulbs, paint, household cleaners, motor oil or other universal/hazardous waste? Do not put these items in the bags! These items must be recycled separately – leave hazardous items neatly consolidated next to trash and recycling bins. Napa County staff will pick them up after the event.



- ♻️ You may find all kinds of things, even the kitchen sink! Leave large items next to bins if they are too heavy to put inside – remember to recycle metal items and place other bulky items in the trash.
