Azteca Market in St Helena Azteca Market is using the commercial compost program, as well as source separated cardboard and mixed recycling with Upper Valley Disposal & Recycling. I will be working with them on how to comply with AB 827. They did make one attempt but found the compost stream too contaminated to be added to the UVD&R compost carts.

Pacific Union College (PUC) in Angwin PUC signed onto service with UVD&R in July 2020 after self hauling and running their own sorting facility for many years. I did a site visit at the cafeteria and the market that are both owned by PUC. They have commercial compost, source separated cardboard and mixed recycling with UVD&R.

Arroyo Grande Villas in Yountville Arroyo Grande Villas in Yountville is a 25 unit apartment complex run by Napa Valley Community Housing. They use a landscaping company that takes yard waste with them to a compost facility. They have some recycling bins in the community room. There are two enclosures for residents with trash and recycling carts. I plan to coordinate with them for adding on green compost carts, for residents to separate food and food soiled paper. They offer educational opportunities for residents so this is a perfect opportunity to fine tune a method for education of multi family properties on compost.

Stonebridge Apartments in St Helena Stonebridge Apartments in St Helena is an 80 unit apartment complex run by EAH housing. They have a landscaping company that leaves yard waste on-site in a yard waste bin. They have recycling carts and trash bins in four enclosures on the property. It appears they are now using a company called TrashLogic to help manage the enclosures, pick up trash around the property and roll recycling carts to the curb for service. They have a resident services manager, I plan to coordinate with them for education on how to separate food and food soiled paper for compost.
