The City of Napa has submitted a proposal for a Proposition 50 Urban Water Use Efficiency Grant that will help establish a Napa County Green Gardener Certification Program. The Department of Environmental Management is sending this letter to express our support for this proposed training effort. This department implements solid and hazardous waste reduction and recycling programs and is supportive of other efforts to educate about natural resource conservation.

Napa County is eager to educate its local gardening professionals to embrace more water-efficient and lowerpolluting practices. Potential local benefits include improved water quality in the Napa River watershed and more reliable local surface and groundwater supplies. More water-efficient landscaping also has the potential to reduce the region's demand for Delta water, meeting one of the primary goals of the Proposition 50 grant program.

We are particularly supportive of the bilingual component of the proposal as we understand the Green Gardener classes will be conducted in both English and Spanish.
